

**PARK CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING
PARK CITY BOARD OF CANVASSERS
SUMMIT COUNTY, UTAH
OCTOBER 13, 2003**

I ROLL CALL

Mayor Dana Williams called the special meeting of the City Council, acting as the Board of Canvassers, to order at approximately 3:45 p.m. at the Marsac Municipal Building on Monday, October 13, 2003. Members in attendance were Dana Williams, Jim Hier, and Fred Jones. Peg Bodell, Kay Calvert, and Candace Erickson were excused. Staff members present were Tom Bakaly, City Manager; and Cindy LoPiccolo, Deputy City Recorder and Election Officer.

II NEW BUSINESS

Resolution accepting the Official Canvass of the October 7, 2003 Primary Election held in Park City, Utah – There was discussion about Candidate Dean Shulman withdrawing his candidacy on October 10, and how it impacts the candidates advancing to the November election. Cindy LoPiccolo explained that state law does not clearly address this for municipalities, but legal staff has determined that five candidates, instead of six, will proceed. Jim Hier, "I move to adopt the Resolution accepting the Official Canvass of the October 7 Primary Election". Fred Jones seconded. Motion carried.

Candidates Mark Blue, Larry Kase, Tim LaPointe, Ron Shepard and John B. Sutton will not advance.
