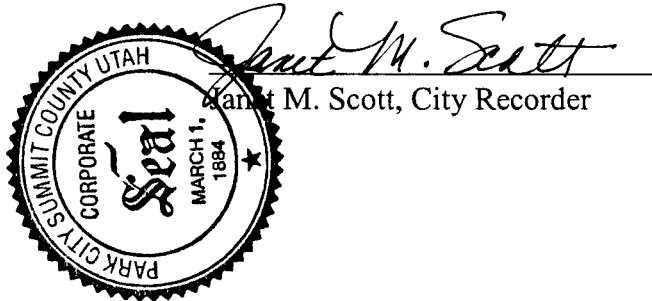

Since City Council member Shauna Kerr was elected to the office of County Commission in Summit County, her seat will be vacated in January 2001.
